Throughout the 1960s, Arnie's Mr. B's Passionate Poncho, Mystery Tornado, Star of the Circuit I and II, Tameless Tiger, and Super Judge all contributed to dispel the myth that a simple farmer couldn't dominate straight-line racing. Arnie was an innovator, fierce competitor, entertainer and showman who always gave fans their money's worth at the track. He is still brand loyal—sticking with Pontiac long after production models ceased. Arnie has always been a fan favorite for this reason, and he continues to exhilarate fans at the track with his cast of potent Pontiacs.
