Stante la sua natura di legge delega è un provvedimento che produrrà pienamente i suoi effetti nei prossimi mesi quando saranno approvate le relative norme di attuazione; - la L. 27 dicembre 2013, n. 147 (Legge di stabilità per il 2014) che, come di consueto, ha introdotto numerose novità con particolare riferimento alla fiscalità locale (istituzione dell'IUC, imposta unica comunale), all'IRAP, all'IRPEF e alla gestione del contenzioso. The white notebooks contain writings, reflections, and

observations about the urban experiences. These notes were often written during trips. The black notebooks, on the other hand, seek to lay out the scope of our research and to describe architecture as we practice it, namely by discussing the major themes that run through our projects. There are no direct connections between these different parts, aside from the ones that readers may of course decide to make.
